

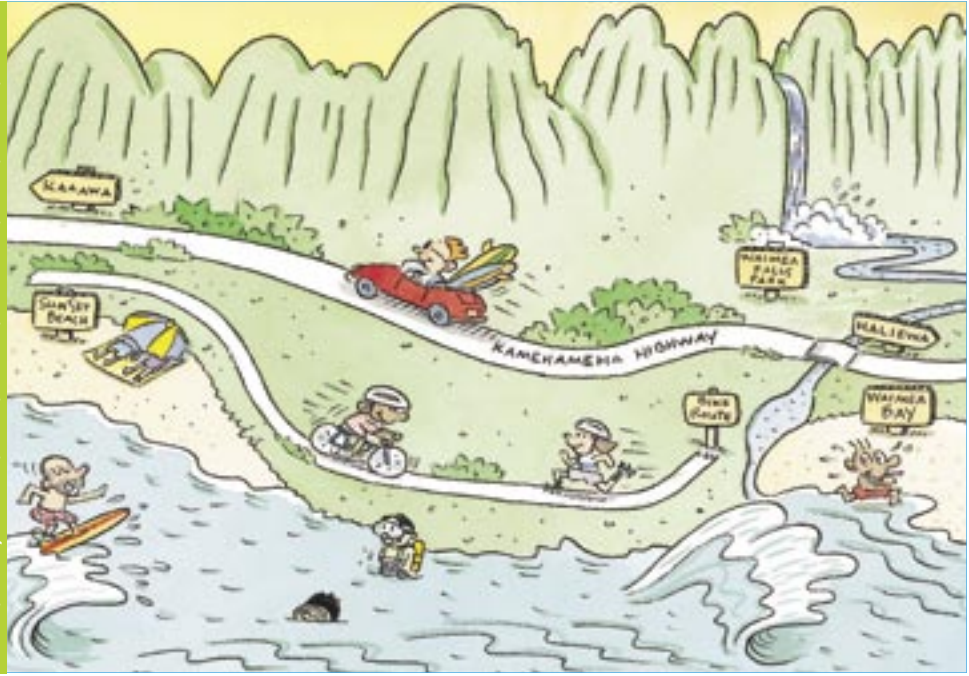


3 Waimanalo Beach Park

Location: Waimanalo

Description: Gentle, rolling waves make this a great spot to body board and swim. Enter the Waimanalo Bay Recreation Area via Aloiloi Street. From the entry gate toward the beach park to the first public restroom building is 0.75 miles. The distance from the Aloiloi Street gate to the rock wall and small boat ramp at the end of the beach is 1.6 miles.

Tip: Watch for Portuguese men-of-war during strong trade winds.



4 North Shore Beaches

Location: North Shore

Description: A paved 2.8-mile path with easy access to area beach parks. This route is part of the Keala Pupukea Bike Path along the coastline from near Shark's Cove to just past Sunset Beach. Powerful winter waves are fun to watch, but most water activities are recommended only in the summer months when the ocean is calm.

Tip: Be aware of traffic — the path intersects cross streets throughout the route.
